DAY 1 • LAGOS, NIGERIA

Your West African journey begins in Lagos, one of Africa's most dynamic cities and the cultural and commercial heartbeat of Nigeria. At the agreed time, **Samap Travels & Tours will pick you up from your hotel or agreed location** and begin your private exploration of Lagos.

Makoko Floating Community. We begin with a guided canoe experience through the remarkable Makoko waterfront community. Travelling through its waterways provides a completely different perspective of Lagos. Makoko is a living residential community, and we conduct this experience respectfully and with local support.

Lekki Conservation Centre. We continue to one of Lagos's most popular nature attractions. Walk through the conservation environment and, subject to weather, safety and operational conditions, experience the famous canopy walkway.

Nike Art Gallery. Explore one of Nigeria's best-known art destinations, with paintings, sculptures, textiles and traditional artworks reflecting Nigeria's artistic identity and contemporary creative culture.

Lagos Arts & Crafts Market. Browse African fabrics, carvings, paintings, jewellery, leatherwork, decorative pieces and locally produced souvenirs.

After the day's experiences, **Samap Travels & Tours will return you to your hotel in Lagos.**

BADAGRY SLAVE HERITAGE EXPERIENCE

After breakfast, we begin our journey west from Lagos towards Benin Republic. **Today takes us through Badagry's powerful history before continuing across the border to experience the culture, heritage and traditions of Benin Republic.**

Our first destination is **Badagry**, one of Nigeria's most significant historical towns connected to the transatlantic slave trade. Through its heritage locations, we explore the history of enslaved Africans who were held and transported through the region.

Our experience **will include historical museums and relics, former holding locations, the Attenuation Well and locations associated with the historic Point of No Return route.**

Badagry provides an important foundation for understanding the connected histories we will encounter later in Ouidah, Agbodrafo and Cape Coast.

NIGERIA-BENIN BORDER CROSSING

From Badagry, we continue towards the **Seme-Krake international border**. **Samap Travels & Tours assists you through the border-crossing process with our protocol services**, while coordinating the transportation and travel logistics required for the onward journey into Benin Republic.

After the crossing, the journey continues towards Cotonou and Ouidah, linking Nigeria's Badagry heritage directly with the historical and cultural experiences awaiting us in Benin Republic.

COTONOU • AMAZON STATUE

Our first major stop in Benin is Cotonou, where we visit the monumental **Amazon Statue**. This striking landmark honours the legendary women warriors of the historic Kingdom of Dahomey and provides a memorable introduction to Benin's powerful history.

OUIDAH • HISTORY, HERITAGE & VODUN

We continue to **Ouidah**, one of West Africa's most historically and spiritually significant destinations. Ouidah's history connects the Kingdom of Dahomey, European trading activity, the transatlantic slave trade and Vodun - an indigenous spiritual tradition with deep roots in the region.

Our Ouidah experience includes important cultural and historical sites such as the **Sacred Forest and Temple of Pythons**, together with locations connected to Ouidah's slave-trade history.

The experience provides an opportunity to understand Vodun as a living spiritual and cultural tradition rather than simply as a tourist attraction.

After completing the day's programme, **Samap Travels & Tours will take you to your accommodation in Ouidah.**

OVERNIGHT: OUIDAH, BENIN REPUBLIC

Day 2 therefore connects the historical narratives of Badagry with Cotonou's modern national symbolism and Ouidah's deep heritage, creating one of the most culturally significant days of the journey.

TOGOVILLE CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

After breakfast, we continue west towards Togo. Samap Travels & Tours coordinates the day's transportation and assists with the cross-border process as we enter the third country of our journey.

Our Togo experience takes us towards **Togoville**, a historic community situated near Lake Togo. **The experience includes crossing Lake Togo by boat**, providing a memorable approach to the community and an opportunity to experience the atmosphere of the lake.

Togoville offers an opportunity to explore traditional community life and learn about indigenous spiritual traditions, colonial encounters, Christianity and the historical events connected to the country's identity.

AGBODRAFO SLAVE HERITAGE

We continue to **Agbodrafo**, another important location connected to the history of the transatlantic slave trade. Through selected heritage locations, we learn how enslaved Africans were secretly held and moved through this part of the West African coast.

This experience connects another chapter of the historical journey between Badagry, Ouidah and our eventual visit to Cape Coast Castle.

From Agbodrafo, we continue towards Lome for the capital-city and cultural experiences that complete Day 3.

LOME CITY & CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

We continue to Lome, Togo's lively coastal capital.

A major focus of our Lome experience is the famous **Traditional Fetish Market**, where we gain insight into indigenous spiritual traditions, traditional healing practices and beliefs that continue to form part of the region's cultural identity.

As time permits, we will also explore some of Lome's popular attractions and landmarks, including **Independence Monument, Place de l'Independance, Lome Cathedral, Grand Marche and selected areas along the city's Atlantic coastline.**

These are living traditions and communities, and Samap Travels & Tours approaches such experiences with cultural sensitivity and respect.

After completing our Lome programme, we will take you to your hotel or agreed drop-off location. The four-day tour concludes after the scheduled drop-off.

TOUR CONCLUDES: LOME, TOGO

The final day combines cultural heritage, community traditions and city life, providing a broader understanding of Togo and a memorable conclusion to the journey through Nigeria, Benin Republic and Togo.

INTERNATIONAL BORDER CROSSINGS

The Nigeria-to-Togo itinerary involves two international land-border crossings:

Nigeria → Benin Republic • Benin Republic → Togo

Samap Travels & Tours assists you through the border-crossing process with our protocol services, while coordinating the transportation and travel logistics required for a smooth transition between each country.

ESSENTIAL TRAVEL PREPARATION

- **Passport & Travel Documents:** Ensure your passport meets the entry requirements applicable to all three countries and has sufficient validity and blank pages.
- **Yellow Fever Certificate:** Carry a valid Yellow Fever vaccination certificate where required and keep it with your passport.
- **Tour Pace:** Expect road travel, international border crossings, walking and full sightseeing days. Some departures may be early.
- **Travel Documents:** Keep your passport, visas/eVisas and Yellow Fever certificate accessible during international border movements.

We coordinate scheduled transportation and provide protocol assistance during the international land-border transitions included in the itinerary.

Keep all required travel documents readily accessible so each border movement can be handled efficiently.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- **Clothing:** Lightweight clothing and comfortable walking shoes are recommended. Modest clothing is appropriate for sacred and traditional sites.
- **Personal Essentials:** Bring prescribed medication, sun protection, a phone charger or power bank, travel adapter and a small day bag.
- **Responsible Travel:** Some experiences take place within residential communities, sacred locations and active spiritual environments. Respect local customs, privacy and photography restrictions.
- **Lake Togo Boat:** The scheduled crossing forms part of the Day 3 cultural experience.

PRACTICAL TOUR GUIDANCE

West African overland travel can occasionally be affected by traffic, weather, road conditions, border processing times, public events and attraction operating hours. Where an adjustment becomes necessary, **Samap Travels & Tours will professionally manage the programme and make reasonable efforts to preserve the principal experiences in the confirmed itinerary.**
